

Dear colleagues! Further I would like to say a few words in order to present myself as the delegate participant for the forthcoming Summer School on 'Mountain Ecosystems and Resource Management'. From 2006 to 2011 I was a student at Yaroslav Mudryi National Law University (Kharkiv, Ukraine). From 2011 to 2014 studied as a post graduate student at the Department of Land and Agrarian Law of Yaroslav Mudryi National Law University. In 2014 became a PhD with the dissertation on the specialty 12.00.06 "Land Law; agrarian law; environmental law; natural resource law". The dissertation's topic is "Legal principles of land zoning within settlements". Since 2014 I'm working as an associate professor at the Department of Land and Agrarian Law of Yaroslav Mudryi National Law University.

I have scientific publications and educational and methodical works (total number - 110). Abstract (100-300 words)	The article analyzes the modern market of organic products, which, in terms of growing consumer demand for environmentally friendly and safe for human health, is very perspective for Ukraine. The increase in the area of agricultural land allocated for organic production, the number of domestic organic operators, the everincreasing volume of exports of organic products to other countries indicate a steady trend of growth and further development of this market. However, there is a need to implement a set of measures, among them: improving legal support; formation of the infrastructure of the organic products market; ensuring adequate state support; improving the system of standardization and certification of production, processing, storage and transportation of organic products; introduction of an effective system of control, sale of organic raw materials, its processing, sale of organic products.
