Abstract (100-300 words)	Livestock is one of the leading, historically traditional for Ukraine agricultural industries. Cattle farming, especially meat, has always played an important role in overcoming the food problem. However, the historical events of February 2014 significantly affected the economic situation in the country as a whole. Special losses were suffered by enterprises working on imported raw materials, the cost of which in the structure of production costs averages 80-90%. In the Khmelnytsky region, as in Ukraine in general, most meat processing companies work with intermediaries to purchase meat on the bones, in blocks, carcasses, and so on. This is due to a critical reduction in agricultural producers, including cattle, which has significantly reduced livestock procurement. In addition, in recent years, the cost of incoming imported raw materials, for example, at the meat processing plant LLC "Kamyanets-Podilsky Poultry" has increased almost threefold. Due to the above, processing
